Warning! Due to increased incidents of students in possession of marijuana on school property, we will be increasing the frequency of police K-9 searches at Tosa East.

The dogs will search lockers, classrooms and vehicles parked in the lot and surrounding streets. If a police dog indicates you have drugs in any of those areas, you and your property will be searched!



Consequences: Any student found in possession of marijuana or any other narcotic on school property will be arrested, suspended and possibly expelled. Students identified as selling drugs or in possession of a narcotic for a second time, will be charged with a felony and face an expulsion hearing.



Quick \$50.00 Program: Information provided to police that leads to an arrest for any crime committed on school property is worth \$50.00. Ask your School Resource Officer about the "Quick 50" program. You will remain anonymous, receive cash money and won't be named in any police reports.



Facts:

- Your phone may be seized and searched in drug related offenses
- Evidence from your phone implicating your friends may lead to their arrest
- All deleted content on your phone can be recovered by police
- Evidence of drug use may result in a search warrant for your home
- Drug arrests can impact your college and career choices and financial aid
